

Graduate Medical Education Financial Aspects

The Lebanese American University Gilbert and Rose Marie Chagoury School of

Medicine provide residents with the below financial support and benefits:

I. Financial Support

Residents at the Lebanese American University Gilbert and Rose Marie Chagoury School of

Medicine get paid a monthly stipend in Lebanese Pound.

The stipend differs according to PGY Level.

Residents' stipend is subject to Lebanese income tax that is at a progressive scale.

II. Benefits

Category	Benefit
Call Rooms	Call rooms are provided by the hospital to residents/ fellows required to have in-house, overnight call.
Health Care and Health Insurance Plan	There is a health insurance plan available for residents through the medical school. It is the Resident's obligation to enroll in the benefit program(s) he/she desires.
White Coats/Scrubs /Laundry Services	White coats and scrubs are provided to new residents/fellows by the hospital. They are requested to get their measurements taken upon starting their residency. Laundry service is provided at LAUMC.



Graduate Medical Education Financial Aspects

Life Support Training	Residents with patient care contact are required to be certified in Advanced Cardiac Life Support Course (ACLS), Basic Life Support (BLS) and Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) as well as in Infection Control. These courses are provided by LAU SOM.
Meal Tickets	Residents on call at the Medical Center are entitled to 2 meal tickets per 24h on call.
Parking	Residents will have parking permit at the hospital. A discounted flat fee for parking access will be 3,000 LBP per day.
Professional Liability Insurance (Malpractice)	Professional Liability Insurance. LAUMC provides its residents/fellows with professional liability insurance coverage while the Resident is acting within the scope of his/her assigned program activities, consistent with the coverage provided to other medical/professional practitioners.
Work Related Injuries Coverage	The Resident has coverage for disabilities resulting from activities that are part of the educational program.
